Only special resolution(s) is/are permitted on this form. A special resolution to change the company name must be completed on Form G1Q. A resolution is required to be filed, within 15 days of the passing or making of the resolution, under section 198 of the Companies Act 2014. Please note that where a special resolution amends the constitution, an amended copy of the constitution must be submitted with the form. Public Limited Companies (PLC), Companies Limited by Guarantee (CLG) and Unlimited Companies cannot pass a majority written resolution.

note two

Tick the relevant box(es). If a meeting was held, the address where the meeting took place must be entered. In all cases, the date must be given.

note three

If the company is altering its principal objective, then this box can be completed and the new NACE code entered. The NACE code is the common basis for statistical classifications of economic activities within the E.U. The four digit NACE code and general nature of the activity **must** correspond with the company's principal objective in the accompanying memorandum of association. **The codes are available on www.cro.ie.**
